

# 哥伦比亚大学语言文化 课程内容介绍

## 哥伦比亚大学英语语言课程内容介绍

哥伦比亚大学美国语言课程(ALP)成立于 1911 年。是美国历史最悠久的语言课程之一。英语语言课程每周进行至少 15 小时的语言学习,全面发展学生的听、说、读、写能力。

根据该测试成绩,同学们将被划分为 10 个不同的等级,从而最大程度的为学生安排适合于他们英语水平的课程。课程开始后的第一周,如果学生实际英语水平与所在班级级别不匹配,还可以要求重新调整班级。

在整个课程中,老师将模拟日常生活,着重于介绍美国社会及其风俗。哥大的英语语言学习有不同程度的课程,可以满足不同英语水平能力学生的要求。全部采取分级别教学、小班授课的方式,每个班级 12 名左右同学,配有 2 个教学老师和一个 level leader,level leader 具体负责各种学生事务以及学生班级的调整。初中级课程偏重于提高学生的口语、听力、阅读水平,高级课程更偏重于阅读和写作能力的培养。

哥大英语语言学习的教学方式灵活多样,除常规的课堂教学外,还包括电影赏析、语音实验室教学、戏剧欣赏、参观博物馆、参加各种球赛、听音乐会、看表演、郊游、聚餐以及参加各种丰富多彩的社会活动。同学们在提高英语水平的同时,也有机会在老师的带领下深入的体验和了解美国的风土人情和文化。
