<b>Application Procedure</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• The application should be consulted and processed between designated staff members at home and host institutions, not on an individual basis.</li> <li>• Graduate students can get an official admission only after being reviewed and approved by the department or laboratory of their chosen fields.</li> </ul>
<b>Qualifications</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• a minimum 2.0 out of 4.5 cumulative GPA or 70 out of 100 points equivalent at home institution and;</li> <li>• a proof of English or Korean Language Proficiency (Minimum TOEIC 600 or TOEFL PBT 487 or CBT 163 or iBT 57 or TOPIK Level 2)</li> </ul> <p>※ If a student does not meet the qualification requirements stated above, Section B in his/her recommendation letter must be filled out by a student's academic supervisor.</p> <p>※ Exchange students do not need to take any Korean language proficiency test before entering Inha University. However, students are recommended</p>

	to take Korean language courses at Inha.
<b>Visa Requirement</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Foreign students seeking study in Korea should have a student visa(D-2) which can be obtained in the nearest Korean Embassy or Consulate. When applying for visa, students are required to submit “Certificate of Admission” which will be officially issued by Inha University</li> <li>• Every foreigner, who wishes to stay in Korea more than 90 days, should be registered and issued an “Alien Registration Card” at the Immigration Office in Korea.</li> </ul> <p>See <a href="http://eng.inha.ac.kr/stulife/immigration_procedures.asp">http://eng.inha.ac.kr/stulife/immigration_procedures.asp</a> for details.</p>
<b>Arrival Day</b>	<p>Exchange students are expected to arrive immediately before each semester starts according to the dormitory schedule.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Fall 2012: August 31, September 1</li> <li>• Spring 2013 : March 1~2</li> </ul>
<b>Airport Pick-up</b>	<p>Students can directly apply for airport pick-up service online at <a href="http://www.airhelp.co.kr/english/index.html">http://www.airhelp.co.kr/english/index.html</a></p> <p>The fee is about KRW 75,000 and this is subject to change without prior notice.</p>
<b>Insurance</b>	<p>All international students are expected to obtain insurance coverage. International students can purchase insurance policy from any insurance company in Korea or in their home country, but their insurance policy should cover accident/illness more than USD 10,000. International students may also purchase insurance after they arrive at Inha.</p>
<b>Accommodation</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Exchange students will be guaranteed on-campus housing at their own expenses.</li> <li>• Application for on-campus housing should be made when submitting the admission application materials and payment can be made in cash upon arrival.</li> <li>• Dormitory fees (Fall 2012) : approx. KRW 914,350 <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>※ 4 people, shared bathroom &amp; shower room</li> <li>※ Dorm Fees for Spring 2013 is not determined yet.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• One semester runs for 16 weeks, and approximate costs of KRW 500,000 are needed for each winter/summer break additionally.</li> <li>• Dormitory fees are subject to change every semester.</li> <li>• Exchange students are allowed to accommodate only at quadruple rooms.</li> <li>• Breakfast and dinner from Monday through Friday are included in the dormitory fees shown above. All lunches and meals for weekends and holidays should be purchased separately.</li> <li>• Students looking for an off campus housing should apply in time with the designated application form.</li> </ul>
