★Note	*Please note that depending on the faculty/department, they do not open English courses and require high level of proficiency in Korean. (<i>Department of Korean Language and Literature</i> requires high proficiency in Korean in order to take major courses.)

D. Admission Procedure

Number of Student Accepted	Depending on the MoU and the exchange imbalance, the number of students is negotiable each year.
Nomination Deadline	-Spring semester: 6th October -Fall semester: 6th April
Online Application	-Spring semester: 1 October ~ 31 October -Fall semester: 1 April ~ 30 April *After the internal screening at the home university, each applicant submits the online application.

Application Outcome & Sending a Certificate of Admission (by post)	-Spring semester: by the end of December -Fall semester: by the end of June *PNU International Office will post the original copy of certificate of admission to the international office at the partner university.
Sending a Pre-Arrival Guide (by email)	-Spring semester: 30 December -Fall semester: 30 June *PNU International Student Center(ISC) will send a pre-arrival guide to each student by email.

Overseas Traveler's Insurance	<p>-All exchange students must purchase overseas traveler's insurance at their home country.</p> <p>-The insurance must cover the medical expenses incurred outside student's home country to a minimum of USD10,000.</p> <p>*Those who do not Hold insurance are not allowed to apply for PNU dormitory.</p>
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G. Visa

Sending A Certificate of Admission	<p>PNU International Office sends the original copy to the international office at partner university by post.</p> <p>Please forward the original to each student in order to apply for student visa.</p>
Application for Visa(D-2) Issuance	<p>All Students are responsible for applying for student visa(D-2) with a certificate of admission at the Korean consulate in their home country.</p>
